Frequently Asked Questions

What is the cost of the Driver Education course?

The cost of the full course, which includes 30 hours of classroom instruction and 6 hours of behind the wheel evaluation, is \$365. Payment option of \$125 for classroom instruction and \$240 at the start of behind the wheel evaluations or \$80 before each of the 3 behind the wheel sessions is now available. Both portions are required by MVA to obtain your license.

Does my student need to have their permit in order to take the driver's education course?

Students do NOT need their permit to complete the classroom portion of the program. However, they will need it before they can schedule behind the wheel evaluations.

Can your instructors teach my child to drive in just 6 hours?

No, we cannot teach your child everything they need to know in just 6 hours. The behind the wheel evaluations guide your teen by assessing their current driving skills, determining where they need more practice, and preparing them for the MVA exam. The parent/adult driver(s) that work with the student for the 60+ practice hours are teaching the teen how to drive.

Sixty hours is a lot, do I really have to drive that much with my teen?

Sixty hours is the minimum you should drive with your teen. Studies show the more hours you practice with your teen directly correlate to reduced teen driving accidents. If you can do more than sixty hours that will help keep your teen safer on the road when they are alone.

How fast can I complete my behind the wheel hours?

How quickly you complete behind the wheel hours will depend on how many hours you have practiced, how proficient you are on the road, and your ability to follow the rules of the road. Lessons are scheduled with at least two weeks in between to allow time to practice insufficient skills. If the instructor asks you to practice a skill for a certain number of hours... please take this seriously. You cannot progress through the lessons and ultimately pass if you have not mastered the necessary skills. We want you to be the safest driver possible on the road.

I am no longer in high school. Do you have daytime appointments available during the week?
