



Cecil College and Arcadia University

Dual Admissions and Core-to-Core Transfer Agreements

Dual Admissions:

- 1. Complete a "Dual Admissions Intent" form at the time of admission to Cecil, or no later than when they have completed 45 transferable credits.
- 2. Graduate from Cecil with an approved Associate degree with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 (Please see Appendix A for a list of degree/majors included in this Agreement).
- 3. Enroll at Arcadia within one year of Cecil graduation.
- 4. Do not attend another institution of higher education between the time they graduate from Cecil and enroll at Arcadia.
- 5. Complete Arcadia's admissions application the semester before they plan to matriculate to Arcadia and satisfy all other regular Arcadia admissions requirements.
 - *There is no obligation on the part of a dual admissions Cecil student if the student decides not to transfer to Arcadia. Once a student has completed the Dual Admissions Intent form, they are strongly encouraged to meet with an Arcadia admissions representative and/or a Cecil academic advisor, counselor or program advisor to develop a course taking strategy to maximize course transferability.

Core-to-Core:

In addition, Arcadia agrees to accept the general education credits embedded in Cecil's Associate degrees noted in Appendix A as meeting all of its undergraduate general education requirements, *except* for the Global Connections Experience and Reflections requirements as well as the senior capstone requirement. This Core-to-Core arrangement applies to all graduates of approved Cecil degrees and is not limited to students who participate in Dual Admissions under this Agreement.
