



Cecil College to Frostburg State University

Dual Admissions:

- Student should apply for dual admission by completing the CC/FSU application to Dual Admission form available online and through the transfer advisor at Cecil College.
- When to apply:
 - Student can apply as early as their senior year of high school but no later than the completion of 30 college-level credit hours at Cecil. Students wanting to apply after 30 credits, will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
- Frostburg B.S. in Engineering Program Coordinator will provide advising to Cecil students through visits to the campus 3-4 times a semester.
- Students who have been accepted must maintain continuous enrollment and meet FSU admissions requirements, including GPA average for the engineering major to maintain their guaranteed admissions.
- Students may change their major at any time, however they will be required to meet the entrance requirements for the new major at the time of change.
- FSU will send an official FSU application to the student prior to the semester they plan
 to officially enroll at FSU. The application fee will be waived. An official transcript from
 CC will be required. Students will receive an official admission letter from FSU once they
 have completed the application and FSU has received their official transcript. Upon
 receipt of the final CC transcript, FSU will complete a final official transcript evaluation.
- The Director of Admissions in each institution will be designated as a representative who will coordinate the Dual Admission Program between the two institutions.
- Students shall be permitted to transfer academic credits earned at FSU to CC to be applied toward completion of the CC Associate's degree, in accordance with the Statewide Reverse Transfer Agreement.
