AS in Nursing to BSN or MSN

Program Requirements:

- Students must meet application requirements for Cecil College as a degree seeking student during the time they are enrolled in the AS degree portion of the curriculum.
- Students must meet the application requirements for Grand Canyon University as a degree-seeking student.
- The AS degree will be awarded by Cecil College upon successful completion of the nursing AS degree option requirements.
- Students must pass the NCLEX-RN[®] examination at the completion of their AS degree, in order to continue to the next level.
- The BSN or MSN degree will be awarded by Grand Canyon University upon successful completion of the option requirements.
