



Cecil College and Pennsylvania College of Art & Design

2+2 Associate of Arts and Bachelor of Photography & Video

Admissions:

Cecil College students graduating with an Associate of Arts will be eligible for admission into Pennsylvania College of Art & Design, provided that students:

- Students must apply for admission within one year after graduation from CC and not have matriculated in another bachelor degree program prior to enrollment at PCA&D.
- Students should submit the PCA&D "Intent to Enroll" form by the time they have completed 30 college level
 credits at CC. Furthermore, the students should file the PCA&D application for admission by April 1, preceding
 fall enrollment.
- Application fees and portfolio requirements for students applying under this agreement are waived.
- Students must meet all standard PCA&D admissions requirements to be accepted, including:
 - a. Admission to the 2+2 programs in this agreement is limited to the fall semester.
 - b. CC students must graduate with an overall 2.5 cumulative GPA; 3.0 average in studio classes. If a student's cumulative GPA is below the aforementioned averages, a letter of support from a CC faculty member is required. PCA&D Admissions may then also require a student with a GPA below the aforementioned averages to submit a portfolio.
 - c. CC graduates enrolling at PCA&D with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above are eligible for a \$2000 PCA&D Partnership Scholarship, renewable for one year.
- Students who follow the prescribed PCA&D baccalaureate degree requirements noted above at CC and have
 earned an Associate degree in the aforementioned transfer program at CC are assured admission to PCA&D with
 a junior level standing. Some additional courses could be required at PCA&D when no CC equivalent course is
 available. In some instances, a CC student may have not completed one to two courses needed to satisfy the 2+2
 agreement's
- Credits earned at or transferred from CC will be limited to 60 PCA&D credit hours.
- CC students participating in the 2+2 program should have completed ENGL 101 and ENGL 102. However, if this is
 not the case, those students who have not completed ENGL 101 and/or ENGL 102 will be required to take
 PCA&D's writing placement test in order to be placed appropriately into PCA&D's advanced Foundations of
 Verbal Communication (FVC) courses.
- Upon completion of their associate's degrees in Fine Art, Graphic Design and Photography & Video, CC students
 who have completed the "Intent to Enroll" application and any subsequent, required materials are eligible for
 financial aid and scholarship opportunities while enrolled at PCA&D. CC students transferring to PCA&D will be
 treated the same as PCA&D students who entered the aforementioned programs at foundation or sophomore
 levels; all students-traditional, transfer, and other, will receive equal access when applying for financial aid and
 will be evaluated equally in the award and distribution of funds.
- CC students transferring to PCA&D, at their will, can be enrolled in PCA&D's Housing Referral Service through the PCA&D division of Student Affairs, which assists all PCA&D students in identifying housing placement through college-sponsored housing or off campus housing near the College.
