## Notes & Recommendations from Towson University:

\*Core 1 at TU is automatically waived for all transfer students.

\*Course equivalents ending in TLL are general lower-level elective coursework at TU.

\*PSY 228 at Cecil Community College transfers as a required course for students interested in the Clinical Psychology Area of Focus within TU's Psychology major. The Department of Psychology offers undergraduates two options beyond the completion of the general undergraduate concentration: a Clinical Psychology Area of Focus and an Honors Thesis in Psychology option (not available at TUNE campus). More information is available in the TU catalog.

\*TU does not accept the grade of "Pass" for any Psychology coursework that applies to the major.

\*Note: Students should complete PSY 201, PSY 224, PSY 227, and PSY 223 at Cecil College. These courses are not offered at TU's TUNE campus. Students who transfer to TUNE without these courses will be required to take them at the main campus.

## Bachelor's degree requirements for all students:

- A cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 is required.
- A C grade (2.0 GPA) or higher is required for all major courses and prerequisites.
- 32 credits of the bachelor's degree must be completed at the upper level (courses numbered 300 or above) at TU
