### ECA AA General Studies to General Education Program

#### Admissions:

- ECA students who wish to transfer to the General Education Program at West Chester University must complete the following:
  - WCU Undergraduate admissions process for first year students

  - The SAT/ACT requirements will be waived
  - The admissions application fee will be waived
  - Placement testing is waived
- ECA students at Cecil College will be considered first year students at WCU and will have access to housing opportunities for first year students.
- ECA students at Cecil College will be considered first year students at WCU and will have access to merit scholarship opportunities designated for first year students.
- ECA students who successfully completed an Associate of Arts in General Studies at Cecil College are guaranteed admissions to WCU but not necessarily to every major. Certain majors have selective requirements and enrollment limitations which may lead to admission into an alternate major.
- ECA students have the opportunity to apply for the Honors Seminar Program

- Upon being enrolled at WCU, ECA students will have the opportunity to apply for the Accelerated Bachelors to Master's program options which enable high achieving students to complete a master's degree in a shorter period of time and at a reduced cost.
