Admission:

Students who are enrolled in the Associate of Arts in General Studies at Cecil who wish to articulate to the Liberal Studies Program at WilmU must complete the WilmU admission process including

- WilmU admissions application
- Application fee
- Submission of all official transcripts from secondary and post-secondary institutions

Prior to matriculation to WilmU, the student will have successfully completed the Associate of Arts in General Studies at CC and will have forwarded final, official transcripts indicating the award of Associate of Arts in General Studies at CC to WilmU.

ECA students who successfully complete the Associate of Arts in General Studies at CC and the courses outlined below and are accepted to WilmU, will enter as a junior with advanced status and are assured transfer credit as indicated. Courses in degree programs not included below will be evaluated by WilmU on a course-by-course basis.
