Eligibility Criteria:

- O Student must be a resident of Cecil County and graduate from a Cecil County Public School in the year in which the award is presented.
- o Student must be in good academic standing as defined by the school.
- o Student must be accepted at an accredited college or university. The award will be given after verification of full time enrollment.
- o It is recommended that the recipient be available to attend the Cecil County Branch NAACP Freedom Fund Banquet in the year in which the award is received.

Procedures:

Applicants must submit the following documents:

- o Completed Cecil County Branch NAACP Education Award Application.
- o Three letters of recommendation addressed to Cecil County Branch NAACP.
- o Recent high school transcript.
- o A 500-word essay (<u>must be typed written</u>) from one of the following topics:
 - 1. Tell us about yourself, your reasons for applying to your respective institution, and your reasons for seeking a college education.
 - 2. What is the value of community service in your community and tell us what it means to you.
 - 3. Indicate a person who has had a significant influence on you, and describe that influence.
